



# WHAT TO PACK

## MUST HAVE ITEMS

- ☐ Alarm clock
- ☐ Bath robe
- ☐ Bedding (for one twin bed/Smedes requires XL sheets), including pillows, and a mattress pad; extra blankets
- ☐ 2 sets of sheets is ideal
- ☐ Cleaning supplies (including laundry detergent, garbage bags, and fabric softener)
- ☐ Desk chair
- ☐ Hand towels (2), bath towels (2), wash cloths (2)
- ☐ Laundry basket
- ☐ School supplies (calculator, notebooks, pens, pencils, markers, highlighters, paper)
- ☐ Shower curtain (1 per suite)
- ☐ Shower Shoes
- ☐ Small to mid-size storage bins with a snap-on lid to keep your food fresh; small drawers to double as a nightstand
- ☐ Toiletries
- ☐ Towels (at least 2)
- ☐ Slippers to walk around the dorm in
- ☐ Water bottle
- ☐ Dress up clothes for formal dinners, professional days, and special events

## OPTIONAL ITEMS

- ☐ Bathroom rug
- ☐ Command™ hooks or strips to hang decorations on your walls
- ☐ Desk lamp
- ☐ Desk organizer
- ☐ Floor lamp
- ☐ Full-length mirror
- ☐ Mini-refrigerator
- ☐ Photos from home (or decorations to make your room more welcoming)
- ☐ Printer and paper (printer available in each dorm and library)
- ☐ Sleeping bag (for overnight trips)
- ☐ Small rug
- ☐ Nightstand
- ☐ Debit card
- ☐ Plastic utensils and paper plates

## WHAT **NOT** TO PACK

Microwave  
Hot pot, rice cooker, or other electronic devices used for cooking  
Heated blankets or heating pads (heating pads are available through the nurse)  
Over the counter meds (all medicine needs to go through the school nurse)  
Lava lamps  
Candles (they are in violation of fire code)  
Bed Risers  
Decorative items that will hang from ceilings (lanterns, string lights, tapestries, etc.). These items are in violation of fire code.  
Valuables – large sums of money, jewelry, or other items of significant value  
Iron (available in laundry rooms on dorm)
